# THINGS TO DO BEFORE YOU APPLY

#### **GET FAMILIAR WITH THE ACEL**

Please spend some time reviewing our website at theacel.com. From the website you will be able to gain a good sense of the sports that the ACEL currently offers and the number of teams participating in each sport. Current year athletic dates are available for download from the homepage. These dates are relatively the same each year and will give you a good idea of yearly due dates and the length of seasons.

#### **READ THE ACEL RULES**

The standing rules for the ACEL are available for download under the Rules tab of the website at theacel.com. Please make sure to review these rules and to ask any questions that you may have before applying or at your application interview. The ACEL defaults to NFHS rules in areas not covered by ACEL standing rules or the sport plan published yearly for each sport.

#### **READ THE ACEL NEW ORGANIZATION BROCHURE**

Please read the ACEL New Organization brochure available for download from the downloads section of the ACEL website containing details that new ACEL organizations need to know for a successful ACEL season.

#### **COST OF ACEL MEMBERSHIP**

An application fee of \$100 is due with your ACEL member application and is non-refundable. Once an ACEL member, there is a yearly membership fee of \$300 per organization. In addition to the membership fee, each varsity sport in which you participate is \$250 and each JV sport is \$150 (Jv track is \$250) due at the commitment deadline for each sport.

Please be aware that membership in the ACEL does require travel to away games. The amount of travel is dependent on the number of teams participating in each sport. Be prepared to travel 3-4 hours for a few away games during the regular season.

Week of August 7: 8-Man Football and Volleyball regular seasons begin

#### **ACEL MEMBERSHIP CLASSIFICATIONS**

#### **FULL MEMBERS**

Current member organizations in good standing eligible for regular season league play, playoffs, and state championship play. Representatives of full member organizations may serve on the ACEL executive board, committees of the executive board, and as sports commissioners.

#### **PROBATIONARY MEMBERS**

Member organizations in good standing eligible for regular season league play, but ineligible for playoffs, state championship play, or representation on all-district/ all-state teams. Probationary members are subject to the one-year assessment period as stated in ACEL Rule 2.2 at the end of which they may apply for full membership. All newly accepted organizations are admitted as probationary members. Full members may be placed on probationary status at the sole discretion of the ACEL executive board.

#### **ASSOCIATE MEMBER**

Current member organization in good standing eligible for regular season league play, playoffs, and state championship play. Associate members have proven themselves by interview to be compatible with the purpose of the ACEL but do not state in their by-laws a doctrinal Christian position. Representatives of associate member organizations may serve on committees of the ACEL executive board and as sports commissioners.

# ACEL MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION PROCESS

#### ORGANIZATIONS APPLYING FOR THE ASSOCIATION OF CHRISTIAN ED-UCATORS OF LOUISIANA (ACEL) MEMBERSHIP MUST SUPPLY THE FOL-LOWING:

- Submit a completed Membership Application Form along with the \$100 non-refundable new member application fee.
- Write a "Letter of Intent to Join" which includes both the history of your organization and why your organization is a good fit for the ACEL.
- Submit at least 3 letters of recommendation from other teams, pastors, and/or schools or associations; preferably teams in the ACEL.
- Provide references from previous leagues and/or athletic associations, if applicable. Two references shall be provided by the applicant for every league and/or association of participation within the last five years.
- Interview with the ACEL Executive Board.

These documents shall be submitted to the ACEL Board of Directors for review. The ACEL Board of Directors will contact the references provided by the applicant. After contacting references, the ACEL Executive Director will schedule an interview between the applicant and the ACEL Executive board. The applicant will be notified by the ACEL Executive Director of the status of their application within the week following the interview.

If selected as a new member, an organization's membership will become effective May 1 with yearly membership fees due at that time.
